

INVESTEC SUPER RUGBY LAUNCH COMPETITION

HOW TO ENTER

To enter individuals must complete the entry form on www.superrugby.co.nz before the end of the competition period.

All valid entries are in to win a trip to Auckland for the 2011 Super Rugby launch to be heard at the Auckland Museum on February 8 2011, including flights, accommodation, and match tickets.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Competition Period

1. The competition commences from Friday 30th January 2011 and closes at Midday on Friday 4th February 2011 . This period is referred to as “the competition period”.

General

2. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. Participation in this competition is deemed acceptance of these Terms and Conditions.
3. Entry is only open to New Zealand residents. Employees (and their immediate families) of the NZRU are ineligible to enter.
4. The NZRU reserves the right, at any time, to verify the validity of entries and entrants (including an entrant’s identity, age and place of residence), and to disqualify any entrant who submits an entry that is not in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or which is false in any material respect, or who tampers with the entry process. Failure by the NZRU to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.
5. Multiple entries are not permitted. Entry is limited to one per person.
6. All eligible entries received during the competition period will be included in the draw. No correspondence will be entered into and the NZRU’s decision on the inclusion of any entry, or the result of any draw is final.
7. Incomplete or indecipherable registrations will be deemed invalid. If there is a dispute as to the identity of an entrant, the NZRU reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine the identity of the entrant.

Draw

8. The draw will be conducted by the NZRU at its offices, 1 Hinemoa Street, Harbour Quays Wellington, on Friday 4th February 2011 and the winners will be announced on www.superrugby.co.nz, on or before the 7th February 2011.

9. 5 prize winners will be notified by phone and email.
10. If, for any reason, the Competition is not capable of running as planned, including due to technical failures or any other causes beyond the control of the NZRU, which corrupt or affect the fairness or integrity or proper conduct of the Competition, the NZRU reserves the right in its sole discretion to cancel, modify, terminate or suspend the Competition.

Prize & Notification Details:

11. Acceptance of the prize constitutes consent on the prize winner's part to allow the use of the prize winner's name, image, voice and/or likeness by the NZRU for editorial, advertising, competition, marketing and/or other purposes without further compensation except where prohibited by law.
12. The NZRU may photograph or film the prize winners while attending any part of their prize, and may use those photographs, or that film, for promotional purposes without further compensation except where prohibited by law.
13. In the event that for any reason whatsoever a prize winner does not take an element of the prize at the time stipulated by the NZRU, then that element of the prize will be forfeited by the prize winner and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize.
14. If any prize is unclaimed by Monday 7th February 2011, and the NZRU cannot through reasonable endeavours contact a winner, the NZRU reserves the right to invalidate the winner's entitlement to the prize, and redraw a new winner of that prize. This process will be repeated until a prize winner is contacted and the prize is claimed.
15. There are five prizes to be won, one by an entrant from each of the New Zealand Super Rugby franchise areas. Prizes consist of:
 - return flights for the winner and a guest (if under 18 years the guest will be his or her parent or care-giver) from the airport serviced by Air New Zealand that is nearest to the winners place of residence¹ to Auckland.
 - 1 night twin share accommodation.
 - 2 Tickets to the Super Rugby Launch held at the Auckland Museum on February 8th
 - 2 tickets to the first home Super Rugby game for the New Zealand Super Rugby team of the winner's choice
 - Transfers by car between the airport and accommodation, and between accommodation and the Investec Super Rugby Season Launch .
16. Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable. The prize is not redeemable for cash or kind and must be taken as offered. In the event the prize is not available, the NZRU reserves the rights to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.
17. The prize winner and their guest (or if under 18 years their parent or care-giver) are responsible for all expenses not specified in these Terms and Conditions, including

but not limited to, travel to and from their home to the airport, insurance, and spending on meals and items of a personal nature (including but not limited to in-room charges). The winner is also responsible for all expenses relating to their use of the match tickets that are part of the prize.

18. Prize travel is subject to Air New Zealand's conditions of carriage. Tickets will not be exchanged for another destination. All components of the prize must be taken together. The prize winner and their travel companion cannot upgrade any prize travel or prize accommodation using cash or frequent flyer points and will not accrue frequent flyer points on any prize flights or with any prize accommodation. The prize winner and their travel companion must depart from the same home city, travel together on the same flights and stay together at the nominated hotel. If the prize winner cannot travel in accordance with these Conditions of Entry and on the flights nominated by the NZRU, the prize will be forfeited. If for any reason the prize winner does not take an element of the prize during the stated period, and on the conditions stipulated by the NZRU or any third parties, then that element of the prize will be forfeited and cash will not be awarded in lieu of that element of the prize. Bookings will be made by the NZRU. Flight schedules and accommodation arrangements are subject to change.
19. The winner is required to organise their own transfers between home and the nearest airport serviced by Air New Zealand.
20. If the winner resides in the Auckland area (such that air travel would not reasonably be required) airfares will be substituted for all car transfers to and from the accommodation.

Release and indemnity

21. To the full extent permitted by law, the NZRU and any of their personnel exclude all liability for any loss (including any damage, claim, injury, cost or expense) which is suffered or incurred by any entrant in connection with the Competition or prizes, including, without limitation: (i) any indirect, economic or consequential loss; (ii) any loss arising from the negligence of the NZRU and their agents (iii) any liability for personal injury or death.

Limitation of Liability

22. No responsibility will be taken by the NZRU or its authorised agents for lost, ineligible, misdirected or late registrations due to technical reasons or any other reason.
23. The NZRU is not liable for the cancellation of all or any part of the prize, for any reason. The NZRU reserves the right to change the prize at any time if the prize becomes unavailable.
24. **Privacy** The NZRU and its authorised agents shall not be liable for any loss (including, without limitation, indirect or consequential loss), damage, personal injury or death which is suffered or sustained (including but not limited to that arising from any person's negligence) in connection with taking or using any prize, except any liability that cannot be excluded by law (in which case that liability is limited to the minimum allowable by law).
25. By entering the Competition, the entrant understands and agrees that the NZRU may use and disclose the entrant's personal information to assist in conducting the

Competition or communicating with the entrant in regard to special offers from the NZRU and Super Rugby Franchise. Entrants in the Competition acknowledge that the NZRU may share an entrant's personal information with the NZRU's related entities which may contact the entrant with special offers. The NZRU is bound by the Privacy Act 1993.
